Four questions. Ten seconds. They stop almost every attack that reaches a business.

01 Is it rushing me?

“Final notice.” “Within the hour.” Urgency is how they stop you checking. Real requests can wait.

02 Is it about money or bank details?

Then phone them — on a number you already had. Never one from the email.

03 Is it asking me to sign in?

Never from an email link, and never from a QR code. Open the app yourself.

04 Was I expecting this?

Unexpected invoice, CV or attachment? Check first. Good spelling proves nothing now.

IF IN DOUBT, OR IF YOU ALREADY CLICKED

Say something straight away.

Nobody is in trouble for reporting. Minutes matter — the damage comes from the hours nobody knew.
